2160. RENEWAL OF ELEVATOR MAINTENANCE

The Superintendent recommends approval for Thyssen Krupp Dover Elevator to service elevators for the 2006-2007 school year. Elevators to be serviced are at Cabell Midland High, Huntington High, Career Technology Center, Barboursville Middle, Cammack, Central City Elementary, Spring Hill Elementary, Village of Barboursville Elementary and the Central Office. They have provided this service for the past six years. The cost for this service will remain the same as the 2005-2006 school year, at \$ 19,503.96. Funding source is Operations.

2161. SECURITY GUARD SERVICE FOR CABELL COUNTY SCHOOLS

The Superintendent recommends approval for Reliant Security to provide Security Guard Service for Cabell County schools for the 2006-2007 school year. This service provides guards at each High School and provides on site service on burglar and fire alarms at all school facilities. Bids were opened on Monday, April 24, 2006. Funding source is Operations.

2162. RENEWAL OF SERVICE – PAINT AND PAINT SUPPLIES

The Superintendent recommends approval for Grinstead PPG paint to supply paint and paint supplies at the same prices as 2005-2006. The approximate amount will be \$10,292.69 for the 2006-2007 school year. Funding source is Operations.

2163. RENEWAL OF SERVICE – GREASE TRAP COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL

The Superintendent recommends approval for Roto-Rooter to provide grease trap Collection and Disposal at the same price as 2005-2006. The amount for this contract is approximately \$17,000.00 for school year 2006-2007. This agreement provides compliance with the Huntington Sanitary Board and the Department of Environmental Protection. Funding source is Food Services.

2164. RENEWAL OF SERVICE – INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT

The Superintendent recommends approval for Orkin Exterminating Co. to continue providing the Integrated Pest Management Program at 33 buildings for the 2006-2007 school year. Orkin has agreed to continue the 2005-2006 rates at \$40.00 per building per month for 33 buildings totaling \$1320.00 monthly. Funding source is Operations.

2165. RENEWAL OF SERVICE- GARBAGE COLLECTION

The Superintendent recommends approval from Allied Waste for garbage pickup and disposal for the 2006-2007 school year. Allied Waste has agreed to continue providing this service at the 2005-2006 rates + a WV PSC approved Fuel Recovery fee of 3.8%. Providing service to all school system buildings will be \$12,688.69 per month. Funding source is Operations.

2166. RENEWAL OF SERVICES – FIRE EXTINGUISHER INSPECTIONS

The Superintendent recommends approval to continue the services from Airgas to continue fire extinguisher inspections at the 2005-2006 price of \$2.75 per fire extinguisher. There are approximately 760 fire extinguishers. This will amount to approximately \$2,090.00 for the 2006-2007 school year. Funding source is Operations.

2167. RENEWAL OF SERVICES – KITCHEN RANGE AND FIRE SPRINKLER INSPECTIONS

The Superintendent recommends approval to continue the services from Airgas for semi-annual kitchen range fire suppression inspections and quarterly fire sprinkler inspections. This will amount to approximately \$7500.00 for the 2006-2007 school year. Funding source is Food Services.

2168. RENEWAL OF CUSTODIAL SUPPLIES AGREEMENT FOR 2006-2007 SCHOOL YEAR

The Superintendent recommends approval for the purchase of custodial supplies from Phillips Supply Co. for the 2006-2007 school year. The approximate cost will be \$400,000.00 for supplies. Funding source is Operations.

2169. RENEWAL OF SERVICE - COMPUTER MAINTENANCE CONTRACT

The Superintendent recommends approval for the Technology Department to renew its contract with nCompass Networks, Inc. of Huntington to provide computer maintenance and networking services to Cabell County Schools. nCompass has agreed to provide services for the 2006-2007 school year at the same bid rates they provided under this year's contract. The rates are \$45 per hour for general technician services and \$75 per hour for network engineering services. The contract is not to exceed \$170,000. Funding will come from the Technology Department line item budget and from E-rate.

2170. SCHOOL TRIP REQUEST – CAMMACK MIDDLE SCHOOL

The Superintendent recommends approval of a school trip/transportation request by Cammack Middle School to take thirty-two (32) eighth grade students to Washington DC trip on May 5 thru May 8, 2006. One day of school will be missed. Travel will be by Advantage Coach with eight chaperones. The only cost to the county will be for one substitute teacher for one day.
