Job Description:

The Recovery School teacher is to provide remediation, instructional, and tutoring services for students who have failed or are failing a core subject in high school. The Recovery School teacher will serve as a mentor and teacher to help students complete course work to show their mastery of the Content Standards and Objectives for core courses. This course work will be assigned and graded by the teacher of record.

Qualifications:

1. Must be certified in the subject area of the particular job posting (Mathematics, Language Arts, Social Studies, Science)
2. Must have experience with high school age students.
3. Preference for individual with knowledge and experience with the students at the respective schools.
4. Preference for individual with experience with and/or knowledge of at-risk students.
5. Preference for individual with experience in remedial education.
6. Preference for individual already employed as a teacher within the building.

Responsibilities:

1. Serve as a mentor to assigned students.
2. Provide appropriate instruction/remediation/tutoring in areas identified.
3. Facilitate completion of required assignments and project.
4. Communicate with teachers of home high school to facilitate student success.
5. Communicate with parent as needed.
6. Keep accurate attendance records and provide attendance data when requested.
